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Monthly Miss Dig Activity Summary

• Wade Trim responded to fourteen (14) Miss Digs utility location requests, eight (8) completed markings, one (1) duplicate request. All requests were closed using the positive response system as required.

Strategic Planning

Replacement of field 2 & 3 Flow Meter electronics. Last month's power failure is believed to be
the cause of the circuit board failure. The parts to repair the meters have been ordered (as
approved).

Maintenance

- Aeration units have been installed in ponds 1 & 2.
- Irrigation system has been reassembled.
- Effluent pumps are reinstalled and are operational.
- Confined space entry was made to investigate effluent flow meter problems.

Cummins Backup Generator

• Monthly and weekly inspections and required maintenance activities were completed.

Super Z Lawn Mower-

• Manufacturer's recommended annual maintenance has been completed.

Other Noteworthy Events or Activities

- Effluent Pump 2 & 3 project has been completed on schedule and within budget. Invoice will be submitted to the authority for review and payment approval soon.
- Last month's power failure has caused several service calls due to control panel circuit breakers being tripped.
- Effluent discharge will continue using field 3 while field 1 & 2 flow meters await repair.
